



LANGUAGE POLICY FOR INCOMING PARTICIPANTS

Given the fact that currently all courses, both at B.A. and M.A. levels are taught in Romanian, our Academy's language policy for incoming students and staff with a minimum of 2-month mobility period makes has in view Romanian language courses provided by the Department of Foreign Languages. The specialized teaching staff in the Department will initially assess the level of the incoming participants and then advise on the type and level of course that should be followed. The courses for the acquisition of the Romanian language are designed in such a manner as to cover both communication skills and specialized vocabulary in accordance to the profile of our institution. The combination between general and specialized Romanian help prospective students with both the acquisition of a foreign language and with the necessary vocabulary for understanding the terminology of the intelligence courses they participate in.

The prospective incoming students and staff for the new M.A. programme in International Relations and European Studies, to be held only in English, will benefit, upon request or advice, from English courses offered by our Department of Foreign Languages, covering, as in the case of learning Romanian, both general communication and specialized vocabulary. All courses will be assigned ECTS.
