<p>Exam procedure</p>	<p>The contest committee evaluates the candidate from the perspective of the following aspects:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) the relevance and impact of the candidate's scientific results; b) the candidate's ability to guide students or young researchers; c) the didactic skills of the candidate related to the position; d) the candidate's ability to transfer his/her knowledge and results or to disseminate his/her own scientific results; e) the ability to work in a team and the efficiency of scientific collaborations, depending on the candidate's field; f) the ability to coordinate research projects; g) previous experiences of the candidate in higher education institutions. <p>The test involves the delivery of a lecture, as the case may be, in the presence of the committee. The program related to the lecture will be published on the website www.animv.ro together with the publication of the announcement regarding the competition. The commission sets the topic for the lecture 48 hours before its presentation and it is published on www.animv.ro.</p>
<p>List of documents</p>	<p>The candidate dossier consists of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) A signed application form (<i>Annex 10</i>) which includes an affidavit pertaining to the authenticity of the information enclosed in it; b) An academic career development plan of no more than 10 pages (which is elaborated by the candidate and which will constitute one of the main criterions for assessment and classification of candidates); c) A signed Curriculum Vitae in both printed and electronic format, which will necessarily include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Information pertaining to completed studies and degrees held; – Information pertaining to relevant to the vacancy work-experience; – Information pertaining to research projects coordinated as director and to research grants won, where applicable, indicating both the financing source, the amount financed and the main publications and/or patents that resulted. d) A signed list of publications (<i>Annex 11</i>) in both printed and electronic format, which will necessarily include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – 10 publications evaluated by the candidate as the most significant in showcasing their academic prowess, which will also be included in electronic format. These publications can overlap with other categorist listed below; – The candidate's doctoral dissertation/dissertations; – Patents and other intellectual property titles (if applicable); – Published books and book chapters; – Articles and research studies published in journals proceeding recognized by the international scientific community; – Publications, <i>in extenso</i>, published in conference proceeding recognized by the international scientific community; e) Academic standards compliance check sheet (template presented in <i>Annex 1</i>) f) A one-page synopsis of the candidate's doctoral dissertation/dissertations written in both Romanian and in English (the synopsis shall not exceed one page for each language); g) An affidavit indicating any potential incompatibilities that would arise in the event in which they would be declared successful in filling in the vacant academic position (<i>see Annex 12</i>)
